



WORDS TO KNOW

Apply	<i>one of 5 Teaching Habits developed through 252 Basics; a clear next step for kids to go and do in order to make real-life application</i>
Bottom Line	<i>the learning aim for the lesson; "Impress": the one thing you want kids to understand from today's lesson</i>
Catch On	<i>small group application time that happens after Power Up; lasts about 25-30 minutes</i>
CG	<i>character generation; denotes instructions to project words or images onscreen</i>
Classroom Facilitator	<i>the administrator of the classroom; leads classroom-wide activities and wraps up Catch On</i>
Faith Skills	<i>5 "skills" we believe every kid needs to master:</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <i>1. Navigate the Bible (survey and locate)</i> <i>2. Personalize Scripture (memorize and apply)</i> <i>3. Dialogue with God (public and private)</i> <i>4. Articulate faith (share and defend)</i> <i>5. Worship with your life (praise and give)</i>
Family Production	<i>a shared experience for parents and children as well as a fun place for families to bring unchurched friends for the first time; integrated with the Bible study/discipleship curriculum of 252 Basics</i>
FamilyTimes	<i>FamilyTimes Virtue Pack: the set of materials The reThink Group produces for families; integrated with 252 Basics and Core Essentials</i>
Fridge Door	<i>take-home notes to parents about what their kids learned today</i>
GodTime	<i>weekly devotionals for kids; integrated with 252 Basics</i>
Host	<i>the "emcee" of large group (Power Up)</i>
Impress	<i>one of 5 Teaching Habits developed through 252 Basics; the Bottom Line for the lesson; the one thing you want kids to understand from today's lesson</i>
KidStuf	<i>what North Point Community Church calls their Family Production</i>
large group	<i>the environment where large numbers of kids (maybe) come together for the Bible story presentation, worship, and prayer; a.k.a. Power Up</i>
NPCC	<i>North Point Community Church, Alpharetta, GA; the incubator church of 252 Basics</i>
Personalize	<i>one of 5 Teaching Habits developed through 252 Basics; a personal example or story leaders can share with kids that makes a point</i>



Plug In	<i>the introductory period/activity in the small group environment; lasts about 10-15 minutes</i>
Power Up	<i>the large group environment in which kids experience the Bible story, prayer, and worship; lasts about 20-25 minutes</i>
Recycle	<i>one of 5 Teaching Habits developed through 252 Basics; 3 Basic Truths we believe every kid needs to master before leaving 5th grade</i>
reThink	<i>the publisher of 252 Basics, FamilyTimes Virtue Packs, First Look (for preschoolers), and XP3 (for students)</i>
SFX	<i>sound effects; denotes instructions to amplify sounds</i>
small group	<i>a group of no more than 10 kids, assigned to the same Small Group Leader for the entire year (or from year to year)</i>
Small Group Leader	<i>works with the same group of kids week to week in the small group environment to build a strong relationship through consistency and community</i>
Storyteller	<i>a master teacher/communicator who presents the Bible story during the large group environment</i>
3 Basic Truths	<i>3 things we believe every kid needs to know and understand:</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><i>1. I need to make the wise choice</i><i>2. I can trust God no matter what</i><i>3. I should treat others the way I want to be treated</i>
Transition	<i>one of 5 Teaching Habits developed through 252 Basics; what you say and do to keep kids engaged as you transition from one segment of the lesson to the next</i>
252 Basics	<i>based on Luke 2:52: And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and men.</i>
UpStreet	<i>the K-5 Sunday morning environment at NPCC, which uses 252 Basics materials</i>
virtue	<i>a biblical characteristic that reflects God's/Jesus' character, or an appropriate response from us toward God, and that He desires for us to emulate; 252 Basics materials are organized around 36 different virtues, 12 per year, rotating on a three-year cycle</i>
Worship Leader	<i>a singer or musician who leads kids and Small Group Leaders in worship, typically during large group</i>
